### FOODBANK DONATIONS

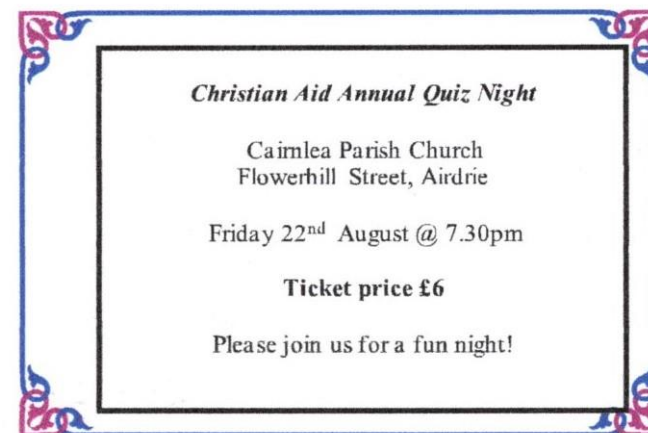
Our collections for the foodbank continue – items urgently required for this week are the following – **tinned fish, tinned meat and tinned vegetables**.
