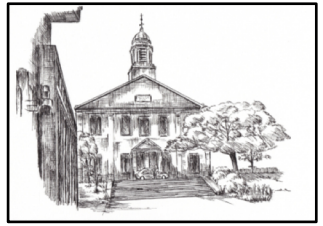


# The New Wellwynd Parish Church, Airdrie

## Opening for Private Prayer:

### *Control Measures to keep everyone safe*



- A Covid-19 Risk Assessment has been carried out and the following controls have been identified by the Risk Assessment, Church of Scotland guidelines and instructions from the Scottish Government.
- Church will be open for private prayer on Monday 10:00-12 noon and Thursday 12 noon-2:00 pm.
- You should not attend if you have any of the symptoms of Covid -19 and carefully consider attending if you are shielding or in a vulnerable group.
- We can accommodate **26** 'slots' at each opening. Each slot will be an individual. Some of these slots will accommodate an additional household member. Slots will be allocated on a first come basis.
- Face masks are not required unless personally desired.
- Private prayer is a time for quiet reflection so please respect this for others.
- The toilets will not be available when visiting the church for private prayer.
- All other parts of the church building will be closed during private prayer time.
- The sanctuary will be cleaned between private prayer sessions.
- You are requested to take any tissues, wipes etc that you have used home with you.

## Arrive at Church

- Maintain Social Distancing outside and inside church grounds
- You might need to queue at church door so please keep 2 metres apart

## Enter Vestibule

- Enter when asked to do so by Steward
- Use hand sanitiser from dispenser in vestibule  
Sanitisers also available for walking aids

## Enter Sanctuary

- Stewards will escort you to an appropriate seat, don't touch anything on way if possible
- Church will be filled from the front
- Observe the one way system

## Private Prayer

- Sit where indicated by markers
- Enjoy a time of prayer and reflection
- No conversation please – respect the quiet time for others

## Departing Church

- Exit church by the Fire doors at front of church
- Please sanitise your hands on leaving and deposit any used masks or tissues in appropriate receptacle.

- When ready to depart signal to a steward who will assist you
- Leave pew same way as you entered it
- Leave by heading towards the front of the sanctuary
