Control Measures to keep everyone safe



- A Covid-19 Risk Assessment has been carried out and the following controls have been identified by the Risk Assessment, Church of Scotland guidelines and instructions from the Scottish Government.

- The toilets will not be available when visiting the church for private prayer.
- All other parts of the church building will be closed during private prayer time.
- The sanctuary will be cleaned between private prayer sessions.
- You are requested to take any tissues, wipes etc that you have used home with you.
