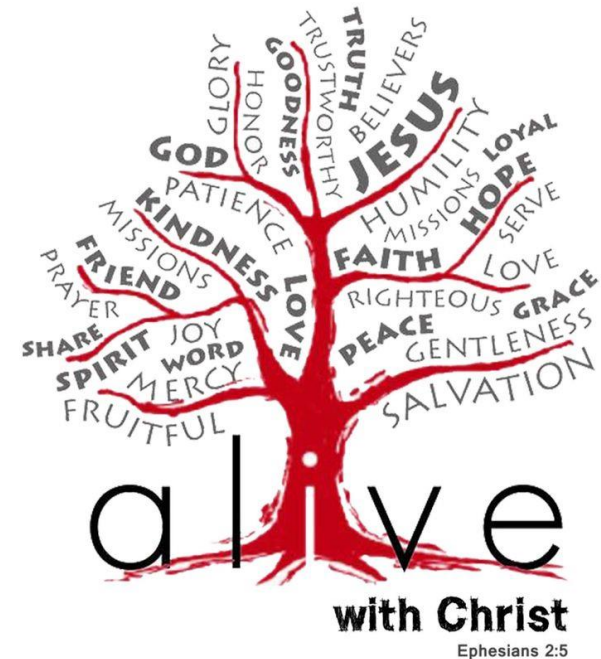

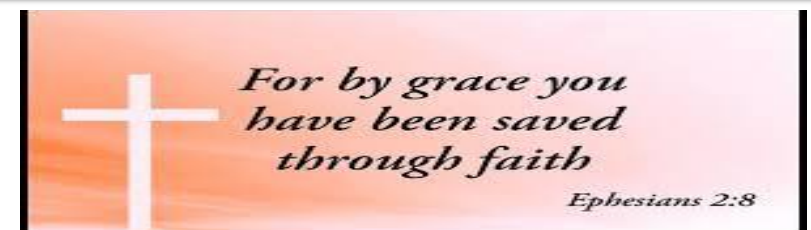

SCHOOL CHAPLAINCY – AIRDRIE ACADEMY CHRISTMAS APPEAL

Mrs. Lynn Carlin, a member of the Support Staff and acting principal of Wellbeing and Families, has emailed **Les** as part of the **Chaplaincy Team** to advise that they are about to start **Christmas gift appeals** at Airdrie Academy for families experiencing hardship.

The **Support staff** along with the **Senior Pupil Family Ambassadors** will be gathering **small gifts** for all family members that will be offered to a group of our pupils – between 130 – 200 this year.
